### 1. What offering did King Hezekiah command to be made when he reestablished the worship of the temple?

"And Hezekiah commanded to offer the \_\_\_\_\_ upon the altar. And when the burnt offering began, the song of the Lord began also with the trumpets, and with the instruments ordained by David king of Israel." **2 Chronicles 29:27**

### 2. After the people had united in this service, how did Hezekiah interpret its meaning?

"Then Hezekiah answered and said, *now ye have \_\_\_\_\_ yourselves unto the \_\_\_\_\_*, come near and bring sacrifices and thank-offerings into the house of the Lord. And the congregation brought in sacrifices and thank-offerings; and as many as were of a free heart burnt offerings."

**2 Chronicles 29:31**

**NOTE.**-The morning and the evening burnt offering, or the continual offering (**Exodus 29:42**), symbolized the daily consecration of the people to the Lord.

### 3. How is this consecration urged upon all Christians?

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye \_\_\_\_\_ your \_\_\_\_\_ a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service." **Romans 12:1**

### 4. What is the continual sacrifice of praise declared to be?

"Through Him then let us offer up a \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ to God continually, that is, the fruit of lips which make confession to His name." **Hebrews 13:15, R.V.**

### 5. How is the service of consecration to be carried forward by the Christian church?
