Nurtured by faith, cultivated with truth, and rooted in His sacred word.*

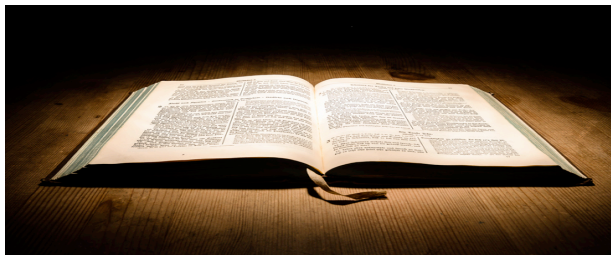
*The Light of Life, he warms the plant, illuminating the way.
