**NOTES:** Thus it is plain that the wicked (the tares) live with the righteous (the wheat) till the end of the world. There is, then, no time before Christ's coming for a sinless state, in which all men will be converted and turn to God. Harper's "Book of Facts," edition 1906, article "Religion," classifies the population of the globe religiously as follows:

From this it will be seen that only about one fourth of the world's population are even nominal Christians.
