Fearful: di-los': from deos (dread); timid, i.e. (by implication) faithless:fearful. This fear refers not so much to physical cowardice as to lack of true faith which faith must be evidenced by public commitment to Christ. Note: Mark 4:40; 2 Timothy 1:7; Matthew 10:32; Romans 10:9-10									
Unbelieving: ap'-is-tos: from 1 (as a negative particle) and 4103; (actively) disbelieving, i.e. without Christian faith (specially, a heathen); (passively) untrustworthy (person), or incredible (thing):that believeth not, faithless, incredible thing, infidel, unbeliever(-ing). Final, unchanging, refusal to believe on Christ as Son of God and personal Savior is the only ultimately unforgivable sin (John 3:18).

Abominable: bdel-oos'-so: from a (presumed) derivative of bdeo (to stink); to be disgusted, i.e. (by implication) detest (especially of idolatry):--abhor, abominable.

Murderers: fon-yooce': from <u>5408</u>; a murderer (always of criminal (or at least intentional) homicide; which <u>443</u> does not necessarily imply; while <u>4607</u> is a special term for a public bandit):--murderer.

Whoremongers: por'-nos: from pernemi (to sell; akin to the base of 4097); a (male) prostitute (as venal), i.e. (by analogy) a debauchee (a person given to excessive indulgence in sensual pleasures) (libertine: a person, especially a man, who behaves without moral principles or a sense of responsibility, especially in sexual matters):--fornicator, whoremonger. "Whoremongers," in the meaning of the Greek pornos, refers not only to pimps but to any who practice or promote sexual activity outside of marriage.

Socrcerers: far-mak-yoos': from pharmakon (a drug, i.e. spell-giving potion); a druggist ("pharmacist") or poisoner, i.e. (by extension) a magician:--sorcerer.

Idolaters: i-do-lol-at'-race: from <u>1497</u> and the base of <u>3000</u>; an image- (servant or) worshipper (literally or figuratively):--idolater. "Idolaters" are those who are devoted to any object, spirit, person or practice which takes the place of God in their lives.

Liars: psyoo-dace': from <u>5574</u>; untrue, i.e. erroneous, deceitful, wicked:--false, liar. "Liars" are those who practice deception and falsehood, especially false teachers (2 Peter 2:1-3; Jude 4,13).
