NOTES: <i>Faith</i> is the first round in the Christian ladder, the first step Godward. "He that cometh to God must <i>believe</i> ." Hebrews 11:6. But an inoperative faith is useless. "Faith without <i>works</i> is dead." James 2:20. To be of value, there must be coupled with faith that <i>virtue</i> , or <i>courage of conviction</i> , which impels to <i>action</i> . To courage there needs to be added <i>knowledge</i> ; otherwise, like the stumbling Jews, one may have a zeal, "but <i>not according to</i> <i>knowledge</i> ." Romans 10:2. Fanaticism is the result of such courage, or zeal. Knowledge, therefore, is an essential to healthy Christian growth.
To knowledge there needs to be added <i>temperance</i> , or <i>self-control-self-government</i> . See Acts 24:25, American Standard Version, and margin of Revised Version. To know to do good, and not do it, is as useless as is faith without works. See James 4:17. Instead of <i>temperance</i> , the Twentieth Century New Testament invariably says

self-control. Patience naturally follows temperance. It is well- nigh impossible for an intemperate person to be patience.

Having gained control of oneself, and become patience, one is in a condition to manifest godliness, or God-likeness.

NOTES: Having become godly, kindness toward the brethren, or brotherly kindness, naturally follows. Charity, or love for all, even our enemies, is the crowning grace, the highest step, the eighth round, in the Christian ladder.
